Spurgeon's First Sermon in the Tabernacle

March 25th, 1861 - 27 years old

It appears that **the one subject** upon which men preached in the apostolic age was **Jesus Christ**. The tendency of man, if left alone, is continually to go further and further from God, and the Church of God itself is no exception to the general rule. For the first few years, during and after the apostolic era, **Christ Jesus was preached**, but gradually the Church departed from **the central point**, and began rather to preach ceremonials and church offices than **the person of their Lord**. So has it been in these modern times: we also have fallen into the same error, at least to a degree, and have gone from **preaching Christ** to preaching doctrines about Christ, inferences which may be drawn from His life, or definitions which may be gathered from His discourses . . . In the days of Paul it was not difficult at once, **in one word**, to give the sum and substance of the current theology. It was **Christ Jesus**. Had you asked anyone of those disciples what he believed, he would have replied, **"I believe Christ"** . . . I would propose that the subject of the ministry of this house, as long as this platform shall stand, and as long as this house shall be frequented by worshippers, shall be **the person of Jesus Christ** . . . if I am asked to say

what is my creed, I think I must reply: "It is Jesus Christ"... the body of divinity to which I would pin and bind myself for ever, God helping me, is ... Christ Jesus, who is the sum and substance of the gospel; who is in Himself all theology, the incarnation of every precious truth, the all-glorious personal embodiment of the way, the truth, and the life.

The Bible is, in fact, God's Word

The God-Ness of Jesus Christ

If the Bible is, in fact, God's Word, then . . . Jesus is, in fact, God's Word made flesh

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. In Him was life; and the life was the light of men . . . And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John bare witness of Him, and cried, saying, This was He of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for He was before me . . . No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, He hath declared Him.

If . . . Then . . .

Logos

A word, speech, or reason; a ground, a plea, an opinion, or an expectation

- It's more than a human word, it's a Divine word.
- It's more than human speech, it's God's revelation.
- It's more than earthly reason, it's the logical syllogism of the Creator.
- It's more than a ground, it's a rock foundation.
- It's more than a plea, it's a divine command.
- It's more than an opinion, it's Heavenly reality.
- It's more than an expectation, it's a solid hope.
- It's more than a Greek word, it's very God of very God.

Reasoning as if the Logos is both True and Divine

The Logos

The If/Then Logic of Heaven

IF the Bible is, in fact, God's Word, THEN Jesus is, in fact, God's Word made flesh

IF the Bible is, in fact, God's Word, THEN what God's Word says about God's Word made flesh (Jesus Christ) in John chapter one is true

IF what God's Word says about God's Word made flesh (Jesus Christ) in John chapter one is true, THEN Jesus is not just a man born 2,000 years ago, but, in fact, He is from before Creation.

> In the beginning was the Word - John 1:1 The same was in the beginning with God - John 1:1 John the Baptist stated, "for He (Jesus) was before me" - John 1:15

IF what God's Word says about God's Word made flesh (Jesus Christ) in John chapter one is true, THEN Jesus IS, in fact, God.

the Word was with God, and the Word WAS God - John 1:1 (emphasis mine)

IF what God's Word says about God's Word made flesh (Jesus Christ) in John chapter one is true, THEN Jesus IS, in fact, the Creator of the Heavens and the Earth.

All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made - John 1:2

The Apostle John Presents the Logic of Heaven

- 1. Jesus is Pre-existent
- 2. Jesus is God
- 3. Jesus is Creator

- 4. Jesus is the full Revelation of the Father
- 5. **Therefore,** He is fit to be the Lamb that was slain to take away the sin of the world

The I AM in the New Testament?

Bonus Thought

The Nomen Sacra

The Sacred Name

In the earliest manuscripts found of the New Testament, from the first to the third centuries A.D., a unique technique was utilized by the early Christian translators when handling the most important Names found within the Bible. Out of extreme deference and respect, the "Sacred Names" were not written out, as would be typical, but were shortened and represented with the first letter and the last letter of the Name and a line above the two (or sometimes three) letters. This lexical technique of showing great deference and respect has been given the Latin description of Nomina Sacra.

The Koine Greek expressed the Holy Name of God, the Son, as . . .

Ίησοῦς

Transliteration: Iésous Phonetic Spelling: (ee-ay-sooce')

The first letter of the Sacred Name being - I (capital Iota) the last letter of the Sacred Name being - ς - (the letter Sigma)

So, with deep reverence, I and the ς are combined together - I ς The ς is then capitalized - I Σ

The final stroke is like a crown, a wreath - a means of capitalizing the already capital letters.

So, if a man could worship Jesus, his Mighty Redeemer, even as he wrote down His Almighty Name, he could write it . . .

10 Building Blocks of Awe

IF

what God's Word says about God's Word made flesh (Jesus Christ), throughout the entire Bible, is true, THEN

Jesus IS . . .

<u>Awe-Striking Thought #1</u> He is from of Old, from Everlasting

He has no beginning and no ending

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall He come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

He is very God of very God

And He (Jesus) was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His name is called **The Word of God**.

By **the Word of the LORD** were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.

The Word of God in Letter is now the Word of God in Life

The Word of God in Law is now the Word of God in Spirit and Truth
