The Word of God in Text - Receive it as, it is in Truth, the Word of God - 1 Thessalonians 2:13 The Word of God made Flesh - Receive Him as, He is in Truth, God Himself

The Word of God in Text - Receive it gladly - Acts 2:41 The Word of God made Flesh - Receive Him gladly

The Word of God in Text - Keep it, follow it, bend to it, and revere it - 1 John 2:5 **The Word of God made Flesh** - Keep Him in the center of your heart, follow Him, bend to His way, and revere Him

The Word of God in Text - Treat it as precious - 1 Samuel 3:1
The Word of God made Flesh - Treat Him as precious

Who is this Jesus?

The Bible Declares that He is over all, God forever, All-powerful, and wholly Sovereign

My God has measured the waters of this earth in the hollow of His hand; meted out heaven with a span; comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure; weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance. To Him, the nations are as a drop in a bucket and are counted as the small dust of the balance (Isaiah 40:12). When He heads off to war, there are none that can stay His hand (Daniel 4:35). He sits as King between

the mighty cherubim, above all, over all, and in control of all – the creator of the heavens and the earth, God of all the kingdoms of this earth (Isaiah 37:16). He can bind the sweet influences of Pleiades, and loose the bands of Orion – He can set the dominion of His ordinances in the earth. He can send forth lightning, number the clouds, and stay the bottles of heaven (Job 38). He is the Mighty God (Isaiah 9:6), The Everlasting God (Isaiah 40:28), Over all, God blessed for ever (Romans 9:5), The God of the whole earth (Isaiah 54:5), and His throne is for ever and ever (Hebrews 1:8). He is the Almighty, which is, and which was, and which is to come (Revelation 1:8), The Creator of all things (Colossians 1:16), The Upholder of all things (Hebrews 1:3), The Father of Eternity (Isaiah 9:6), The Beginning and the Ending (Revelation 1:8), The Alpha and the Omega (Revelation 1:8), The First and the Last (Revelation 1:17). He is The Rock of Ages (Isaiah 26:4), The Head of every Man (1 Corinthians 11:3), The Head of all Principality and Power (Colossians 2:10) Lord of Lords (Revelation 17:14), Lord both of the dead and living (Romans 14:9), Lord of all (Acts 10:36), Lord over all (Romans 10:12). He is The Prince of Princes (Daniel 8:25). The Prince of the Kings of the earth (Revelation 1:5), He that filleth all in all (Ephesians 1:23), The King of Kings (Revelation 19:16), The Righteous Judge (2 Timothy 4:8), The King of Saints, King of Nations (Revelation 15:3), King over all the Earth (Zechariah 14:4, 5, 9), The King of Glory (Psalm 24:10), Crowned with many Crowns (Revelation 19:12), and He sitteth King for ever (Psalm 29:10). And before Him all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and He doeth according to His will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay His hand, or say unto Him, What doest thou? (Daniel 4:35) Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever He had formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, He was God (Psalms 90:1-2). When the kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against Him, He shall laugh: and shall hold them in derision (Psalm 2:2-4). He is bound by nothing but His own nature and His own law. He is not limited in power nor governed in action by the will or the pleasure of any angel, demon, or man. But rather, He is limited and governed only by the dictums and restraints of His loving prerogative to gain for Himself a peculiar people (Titus 2:14), to establish His Kingdom in this earth (Matthew 6:10), and to shed abroad His glory unto the Heathen (Ezekiel 39:21).

And in the not so distant future, when He will return to bring terrible judgment to nations and His feet shall touch down on Mt. Olivet and see it divide asunder – every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that He is Lord (Philippians 2:10). And all will behold the Ancient of days, whose eyes are as a flame of fire, whose voice is as the sound of many waters, and whose countenance is as the sun shining in all its strength (Revelation 1:14-15). They will see the fiery stream issuing forth from before Him; the thousand thousands ministering unto Him, and the ten thousand times ten thousand that stand before Him at the judgment (Daniel 7:9-10). And all will behold the One at whose feet all crowns will be cast, for He is worthy to receive glory and honor and power: for He hast created all things, and for His pleasure they are and were created (Revelation 4:10-11).

So, in concert with the noble King David, I pronounce, "Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all." (1 Chronicles 29:11)
