The Gormandizer

A belly. One who is, in a sense, all belly. One known for their cravings for food and one controlled by their cravings for food. One whose god is their belly. One who devours food greedily and voraciously. One who snarfs their food. One who gorges on food. One whose food is all over their face and one whose passion for food is so great that it disturbs those around them. **In Biblical terms, a Glutton.**

Christianity = Self-Relinquishment

Paristēmi - Pä-rē'-stā-mē

To present and yield unto the rightful owner, the rightful possessor. To place one's self at the disposal of another. To offer up, to relinquish, to make available, to give back to the One who rightfully owns it in the first place.

Neither **yield you** your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but **yield yourselves** unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God . . . Know you not, that to whom you **yield**

yourselves servants to obey, his servants you are to whom you obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? . . . as you have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness . . . I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

The Significance of the Thigh

The symbol of self-strength

And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh; and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him . . . And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved. And as he passed over Penuel the sun rose upon him, and he halted upon his thigh. Therefore the children of Israel eat not of the sinew which shrank, which is upon the hollow of the thigh, unto this day: because he touched the hollow of Jacob's thigh in the sinew that shrank.

The Hollow of the Thigh

the Huckle bone; the Groin; the hollow space where the thigh bone moves; The sexual region of a man - his potency, his strength

The Symbol of Sexual Appetite, Rebellion, and Gluttony

The Brass Kingdom

Thou, O king, saw, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible. This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, **his belly and his thighs of brass**, His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay. Thou saw till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and broke them to pieces. Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.

The Rotting Thigh and Bloating Belly

Then the priest shall charge the woman with an oath of cursing, and the priest shall say unto the woman, The LORD make thee a curse and an oath among thy people, when the LORD doth make thy thigh to rot, and thy belly to swell; and this water that causes the curse shall go into thy bowels, to make thy belly to swell, and thy thigh to rot: And the woman shall say, Amen, amen . . . And when he hath made her to drink the water, then it shall come to pass, that, if she be defiled, and have done trespass against her husband, that the water that causes the curse shall enter into her, and become bitter, and her belly shall swell, and her thigh shall rot: and the woman shall be a curse among her people.

The Curse and the Correction

The Curse - life lived upon the belly in the service of the belly-god; a slave to sexual appetite; a hip swagger on the strong thigh.

The Correction - an emptied belly ready to be filled, bearing the fruit of the Spirit; a servant to righteousness; a thigh touched with a limp of utter dependency.

Ehud - The Man of Consecrated Thigh

And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the LORD. So the LORD strengthened Eglon king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD. Then he gathered to himself the people of Ammon and Amalek, went and defeated Israel, and took possession of the City of Palms. So the children of Israel served Eglon king of Moab eighteen years. But when the children of Israel cried out to the LORD, the LORD raised up a deliverer for them: Ehud the son of Gera. . . Now Ehud made himself a dagger (it was double-edged and a cubit in length) and fastened it under his clothes on his right thigh. So he brought the tribute to Eglon king of Moab. (Now Eglon was a very fat man) . . . So Ehud came to him (now he was sitting upstairs in his cool private chamber). Then Ehud said, "I have a message from God for you." So he arose from his seat. Then Ehud reached with his left hand, took the dagger from his right thigh, and thrust it into his belly. Even the hilt went in after the blade, and the fat closed over the blade, for he did not draw the dagger out of his belly; and his entrails came out.
