# The Separating of the Two

When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats. And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on His right hand,

Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.

Then the righteous will answer Him, saying,

Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?

And the King will answer and say to them,

Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.

Then He will also say to those on the left hand,

Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.

Then they also will answer Him, saying,

Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?

Then He will answer them, saying,

Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.

And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

# The Message to the Church in Sardis

And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write;

These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that **thou hast a name that thou lives, and art dead**. Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God. Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy. He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

The Red Ones

#### Two Reds

- 1. **Red of this Earth** (Adam, Edom, The Firstborn, The Flesh)
- 2. **Red of Heaven** (David, Jesus, The Second, The Twice-born, The born again, the Spirit)

The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.

### Two Reds

- 1. **Red of this Earth** (Those with ears shut to the Spirit)
- 2. Red of Heaven (Those with ears open to the Spirit)

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

#### Two Reds

- 1. Red of this Earth (Those unwilling and unable to bear the anguish of the Spirit of God)
- 2. Red of Heaven (Those willing and empowered to bear the anguish of the Spirit of God)

### After 40... Fire

### God - The Holy Fire

Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent; A fire shall devour before Him, And it shall be very tempestuous all around Him (Psalm 50:3) . . . A fire goes before Him, And burns up His enemies round about (Psalm 97:3) . . . For behold, the LORD will come with fire And with His chariots, like a whirlwind, To render His anger with fury, And His rebuke with flames of fire (Isaiah 66:15) . . . For our God is a consuming fire (Hebrews 12:29).

#### Pentecost

The Ripening of Wheat, The Time for Threshing and Burning Chaff

. . . He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire: Whose fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly purge His floor, and gather His wheat into the garner; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

#### Matthew 3:11-12

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. # A Brief History of the Temple

Then Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in mount Moriah, where the Lord appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

#### 2 Chronicles 3:1

#### The Tribular

the threshing instrument of Pentecost

Every grain of wheat has an appointment with the Tribular, the Threshing instrument (corn, has an appointment with the hooves of oxen). In ancient times, when the grain was threshed, it was winnowed by being thrown up against the wind (Jer. 4:11), and afterwards tossed with wooden scoops (Isa. 30:24). The shovel and the fan for winnowing are mentioned in Ps. 35:5, Job 21:18, Isa. 17:13. The refuse of straw and chaff was burned (Isa. 5:24). Freed from impurities, the grain was then laid up in granaries till used (Deut. 28:8; Prov. 3:10; Matt. 6:26; 13:30; Luke 12:18).

#### Wheat

- To bring about much fruit it must fall into the ground and die
- To make bread it must be threshed and its chaff broken away

### The Floor of Wind and Fire

The Human body - the Holy Temple of Jehovah, where the wheat is purified and perfected and chaff is removed and burned up. That which is impure and imperfect is not allowed to remain.

When the Holy Spirit stakes claim to the Body

# The Holy Spirit's Request

I need to give birth to the Life of Christ in this world. First inside you, then inside others through you. But, to do this, I must have your body. I must have your tongue, your eyes, your hands, your feet, and your heart. I must have your mind, your ears, your time, your talents, and your future. I need a heart to burden, a mind to bear my anguish, a soul to carry my ache, a body to be bent, eyes through which to pour out my tears, a forehead through which to sweat great droplets of blood, and a mouth through which to do my groaning.

# A Kidney Stone

A very, VERY uncomfortable rock-like deposit, stabbing like a knife inside a person as it passes through and, ultimately, out

### A Heavenly Jewel

A very, VERY uncomfortable ROCK deposit, stabbing like a knife in our inner-man as it passes through and, ultimately, out to change the world

## The Holy Spirit's Agenda

- · The Holy Spirit wants to bring Jesus into this world, that others may see, believe, and be saved
- As He deposits His grace into our bodies, this Holy Spirit burden often feels like a kidney stone passing through our
  mind and our heart simultaneously it is the anguish of God, the travail of God's Spirit in the Body of Christ for
  those who are afflicted, lost, and dying.

### To Be His Body is to Bear His Anguish

To be His Body is to bear His stripes, His ignominy, His mockery, and His grief
