THE MAKINGS OF THE TRIUMPHANT HEART

KATAISCHYNŌ - [KA-TICE-K-HOO-NO]

To be put to shame, to be disgraced, to have hope meet with failure

NO KATAISCHYNŌ!

Never to be put to shame, never to be disgraced, and never to have hope meet with failure

Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believes on Him shall not be **confounded (kataischynō)**.

1 Peter 2:6

MOWT - [MŌTE]

to be moved, shaken, overthrown, dislodged

NO MOWT!

Never to be moved, never to be shaken, never to be overthrown, and never to be dislodged

I have set the LORD always before me: because He is at my right hand, **I** shall not be moved (mowt).

Psalm 16:8

Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and He shall sustain thee: **He shall never** suffer the righteous to be moved (mowt).

Psalm 55:22

My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from Him. He only is my rock and my salvation: He is my defense; **I shall not be moved** (mowt).
